AC⁴ Stipends for Columbia Faculty to attend the IACM Conference

The Advanced Consortium for Cooperation, Conflict and Complexity (AC⁴) firmly supports the mission of The International Association for Conflict Management (IACM) to encourage scholars and practitioners to develop and disseminate theory, research, and experience that is useful for understanding and improving conflict management in family, organizational, societal, and international settings.

AC4 gives annually up to two stipends, of \$2500 each to Columbia Faculty to attend the IACM conference. These may be used to cover flights, accommodations, meals and other conference related expenses. Applicants must be accepted to present at IACM.

Applications should include:

1. a 1-page essay which outlines applicant's topic, how applicant will add value to the IACM conference, and how applicant will benefit from this stipend;
2. copy of abstract submitted to IACM;
3. itemized budget (indicating how stipend will be spent).

Stipend recipients are expected to attend an AC4-Sponsored reception at the IACM conference.

Deadline for applications is March 1, 2012 and stipend recipients will be notified by email.
